# **Designated Player (DP) and Flex Player (FLEX)**

## Rule 3.1.3 Designated Player:-

A starting offensive player who bats for the Flex Player.

#### Rule 3.1.6 Flex Player:-

The starting player who is listed in the 10th spot on the line-up card and for whom the DP is batting. The FLEX may play any defensive position and may enter the game on offense only in the DP's batting position.

## Rule 3.1.15 Offensive Player Only (OPO):-

A player in the batting order, other than the FLEX Player, for whom the DP is playing defence.

#### Rule 3.2.4 a)

A DP may bat for any defensive player.

[This means that the FLEX for whom the DP is batting may play in any defensive position]

#### Rule 3.2.4 b)

The DP may play defence for any player including the Flex Player.

[If the DP plays defence for the FLEX, the FLEX player (or his substitute) has left the game, the starting FLEX Player may re-enter once]

#### Rule 3.2.4 b) i.

If the **DP** plays defence for any player other than the Flex Player, that other player continues to bat and is identified as the **OPO**.

The **OPO** is not considered to have left the game and continues to bat but does not play defence.

[The DP could effectively play defence for a different player each inning (ie different OPO each time)]

## Rule 3.2.4 b) ii.

When the **DP** plays defence for the **FLEX**, this is treated like a substitution for the **FLEX** or the **FLEX**'s **substitute** and must be reported to the Umpire. The **DP** may play defence for the **FLEX** any number of times.

## Rule 3.2.4 b) iii.

When the **DP** plays defence for the **FLEX**, the line-up reverts to nine (9) players and the game may legally end with nine (9) players.

# Rule 3.2.4 b) iv.

A team's line-up may revert to ten (10) players by a player;

- 1) entering a substitute in the **FLEX** position; or
- 2) re-entering the original stating **FLEX** player, but only once.

# Rule 3.2.4 c)

The **DP** and the **FLEX** cannot be in the game on offense at the same time.

#### Rule 3.2.5 a)

If a team declares the use of a **DP**, the team must name a **FLEX** on the line-up card.

#### Rule 3.2.5 b)

The **FLEX** is placed in the non-batting position (10th) in the starting line-up immediately following the first nine (9) batting positions and may play any defensive position.

#### Rule 3.2.5 c)

The **FLEX** may enter the game on offense only for the **DP**.

- 1) the line-up goes to nine (9) players when the **FLEX** enters the game on offense. The team can finish the game with (9) players in the line-up.
- 2) The Flex Player may enter the line-up in the DP batting position any number of times. This is treated like a substitution for the DP or the DP's substitutes and must be reported to the Plate Umpire.
- 3) A team's line-up may revert to ten(10) players by a player;
  - Entering a substitute into the DP position or
  - 2. re-entering the original stating **DP** player, but only once.

#### Rule 3.2.5 d)

A **FLEX** who enters the game on offense for a player other than the **DP** is considered an illegal re-entry.

## Example 1:-

Legal re-entry of DP to offence, with FLEX returning to defence (10th position in the line-up).

If the *DP* re-enters, he may play offence and defence (continue the game with nine players), or he may bat in his original place in the batting order, and the *FLEX* returns to the 10th position and plays defence only again.

# Example 2:-

DP replaced with a legal substitute.

The original **DP** (Dunlop), being a starting player, may re-enter the game one time.

Munroe now becomes the **DP**, should he be substituted, he may not re-enter.

## Example 3:-

Legal re-entry of the starting DP (Dunlop) to his correct position in the line-up.

The starting player listed as the DP must remain in the same position in the batting order whenever he is in the game.

Kent (who was not a starting player) may only return to the game as a Replacement Player (under the Replacement Player rule).

## Example 4:-

Illegal re-entry of the starting DP (Dunlop) to an incorrect position in the line-up.

The starting DP (Dunlop) and his substitute (Kent), may not be in the line-up at the same time.

There are two rules covering this; *Rule 3.2.8:-*

*b)* A starting player and their substitute(s) may not be in the game at the same time.

Effect Rule 3.2.8 - Illegal re-entry:f) DP re-entering into a place other than the DP position

This is an illegal re-entry situation, Dunlop and the Head Coach will be ejected from the game.

# Example 5:-FLEX Player replaced with a legal substitute.

The original **FLEX** (Johnson), being a starting player, may re-enter the game one time.

Olsen now becomes the FLEX Player, should he be substituted, he may not re-enter.

# Example 6:-

Legal re-entry of the starting FLEX (Johnson) to defence only (10th position in the line-up).

The starting FLEX may re-enter the game one time, either in the 10th position, or in the DP's position in the batting order.

Olsen (who was not a starting player) may only return to the game as a Replacement Player (under the Replacement Player rule).

## Example 7:-

Legal re-entry of the starting FLEX (Johnson) to offence&defence (in the DP (Dunlop's) position in the line-up).

The starting FLEX may re-enter the game one time, either in the 10th position, or in the DP's position in the batting order (line-up returns to nine (9) players).

The original **DP** (Dunlop), being a starting player, may re-enter the game one time.

Olsen (the substitute FLEX, who was not a starting player) **must** leave the game and may only return to the game as a Replacement Player (under the Replacement Player rule).

# Example 8:-

Illegal re-entry of starting FLEX (Johnson) to an incorrect position in the line-up.

The starting FLEX may re-enter the game one time, either in the 10th position, or in the DP's position in the batting order (line-up returns to nine (9) players).

There are two rules covering this; Rule 3.2.8:-

b) A starting player and their substitute(s) may not be in the game at the same time.

Effect Rule 3.2.8 - Illegal re-entry:e) The Flex going into the game
offensively for a player other than the
DP.

This is an illegal re-entry situation, Johnston and the Head Coach will be ejected from the game.
